# Strip and Finish Procedures

### FLOOR CARE MAINTENANCE

## EQUIPMENT NEEDED

#### Assemble Supplies and Prepare Floor

Proper stripping requires the right equipment. Some or all of it may be necessary for complete and efficient removal of finish.

- Remove any soil and chewing gum with scraper and thoroughly dust mop.
- Place wet floor signs.
- STRIP
- Wet Floor Signs
- Clean Mop
- **Clean Bucket**
- Swing Machine
- Black or Hi-Pro Swing Machine Pads
- Vacuum (to remove stripping solution)
- Burnisher (optional but recommended)
- UHS Pads for Burnisher (optional but recommended)

finish on the floor.

To periodically restore gloss, apply **Citrus** Scrub 'N Shine at 6 oz. per gallon. Burnish the floor using a high speed machine and burnishing pads. Turn pads often to prevent loading. Always dust mop after burnishing.

Apply up to 4 coats

of X-Coat 22 in 24 hours. Applying more

increases the likelihood of a slow cure.

Apply a minimum base of 5 to 6 coats

of finish for optimal

results.
